AFTER ARTHROSCOPIC KNEE SURGERY

- 1. Limit your activities for several days. Use of crutches is usually not necessary.
- 2. Apply ice packs to your knee for 1/2 hour every 2 hours while awake during the first 24 hours.
- 3. Remove bandages in 48 hours-cover incisions with Band-Aids.
- 4. You may shower in 48 hours.
- 5. Reapply elastic bandage during the day.
- 6. Take your pain medication as prescribed
- 7. Take a baby or adult aspirin---one daily for 10 days
- 7. Arrange for a follow-up visit (if not already done) for in one to two (1-2) weeks.
