AFTER ARTHROSCOPIC SHOULDER SURGERY

- 1. Limit your activities for several days.
- 2. Remove bandages in 48 hours-cover incisions with Band-Aids.
- 3. You may shower in 48 hours.
- 4. Take your pain medication as prescribed.
- 5. Arrange for a follow-up visit (if not already done) for in 2 or 3 days
- 6. You may take your arm out of the sling and move around gently, if comfortable.
